In 2002, he set aside his professional interests as an energy derivatives trader in Houston, Texas to found Paradisus Dei, a Catholic lay ministry dedicated to helping families discover the superabundance of God within the home.

Steve's background allows him to profoundly understand the essential role of the family in society and salvation history. His professional experience allows him to present these mysteries in an engaging and highly accessible manner. Audiences have been "astounded" as Steve presents the mystery of the family according to the "Three Wisdoms" of the Church, harmonizing theology with the findings of modern science while providing a vision that touches the divine.

In 2004, Steve developed the That Man is You! men's program, which quickly spread across the country transforming men, marriages and families. Independent research by a Faith Advisor to The Gallup Poll identified it as one of the most life-transforming programs ever studied.
