FORMATION PROGRAM

Paradisus Dei has entered into a unique partnership with professors from the Institute of Church Life at the University of Notre Dame to establish a rigorous, one-year formation program. Faithful to the Church's tradition, this comprehensive program includes intellectual and spiritual formation as well as formation in the practical skills necessary to be effective, fruitful missionaries.

While the formation process for Missionaries covers quite a bit of ground in the retreats, emails, catechism reading, spiritual plan of life, and course work, there is a core message that we want to ensure is lived by missionary couples and then shared with others: the reality that God can be found and adored in their home! Though hidden, God was fully present in the home of Nazareth in the person of Christ, and, through Him, all families can discover God within their home!

Missionaries to the Family are called to be a channel of grace to others. As such, Missionaries should be:

- In a stable, happy, canonical marriage
- In stable relationships with any children still in the home
- Able and willing to dedicate 2 hours per week to formation in the first year and to missionary work in subsequent years.

Important Dates:

- Program Launch: July 26-28, 2024, at the University of Notre Dame.
- Second Retreat: January 3-5, 2025, in Houston, Texas.
- Commissioning Retreat: August 8-10, 2025, at the University of Notre Dame.

For the Formation Class beginning July of 2024:

- Paradisus Dei will accept applications until May 15, 2024.
- Paradisus Dei will notify couples by May 31, 2024.
- Formation begins with the retreat on July 26-28, 2024.

Cost:

- Tuition: \$5000/couple; Paradisus Dei covers \$2500 of this cost.
- Couples are asked to cover the remaining \$2500 plus travel to and from retreats.
- Parishes, dioceses, and foundations often choose to contribute to assist couples.
- Limited tuition scholarships are also available to couples.

SPIRITUAL FRIENDSHIPS IN THE PARISH — IN THE HOME THE MODEL OF THE HOLY FAMILY

Couples who complete the formation year are commissioned as Missionaries to the Family and sent out into the great mission field of the family in their local community and parish.

Missionaries to the Family are formed to imitate the Holy Family in practical ways based upon the 7 Steps to not only divorce-proof their marriage, but experience the joy of living authentic Catholic family life in their homes. It is a joy that is contagious and attractive and invites other families to "come and see" (John 1:29). By inviting others into their homes and lives through spiritual friendship, missionaries greatly impact their parish communities, one family at a time.
